

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND TO THE TOWN OF GREENFIELD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN  
RESOLUTION 2021-1**

**WHEREAS**, Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes set out requirements for long-range comprehensive planning for towns, villages, and cities across the State; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Greenfield has adopted and followed written procedures designed to foster public participation at every stage of the preparation of this amendment containing all of the elements specified in Wis. Stats. 661.11.(4)(a); and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan Commission of the Town of Greenfield, by a unanimous vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, has recommended to the Town Board the adoption of this amendment pursuant to Wis. Stats. 66.1001(4)(b); and


**WHEREAS**, the Greenfield Town Board has conducted a public hearing on January 13, 2021 to take public comments regarding these amendments to the Town of Greenfield Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Land use classifications for a 1-acre portion of parcel 6-181-1 shall be amended from Exclusive Agriculture to Rural so a house may be built.
