## AN ORDINANCE

Providing for a Civil Defense Organization and for the protection and promotion of Public Safety, Health, and Welfare in the Town of Greenfield, La Crosse, County.

The Town board of the Town of Greenfield does ordain as follows;

- 1. "Civil Defense" shall mean the preparation for the carrying out of all emergency functions, other than functions for which the military forces are primarily responsible, to minimize and repair injury and damage resulting from disaster caused by enemy attack, sabotage, or other hostile action, or by fire, flood or other natural causes.
- 2. By reason of the increasing possibility of disaster of unprecedented size and destructiveness, and to insure that preparations will be adequate to cope with such disasters, provide for the common defense, protect the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and to preserve the lives and property of the people, it is hereby declared necessary that we do the following:
  - (a) Establish a local Civil Defense Organization;
  - (b) Provide for the exercise of necessary powers during Civil Defense emergencies;
  - (c) Provide for the rendering of cooperation and mutual aid between this township and other Political subdivisions.
- 3. It is further declared to be the purpose of this ordinance and policy of this board, that all Civil Defense functions of this town will be coordinated to the maximum extent practicable with existing services and facilities of this town; and with comparable functions of the Federal, State and County Governments and other political subdivisions; and of various private agencies; to the end that the most effective preparation and use may be made of man-power, resources, and facilities for dealing with any disaster that may occur.
